



**BIG AIR DOG JUMP**  
**2012 Toronto Sportsmen's Show**  
**March 14 – 18, 2012**

Again this year dogs of all breeds and ages will be competing at the 2012 Toronto Sportsmen's Show's Big Air indoor event. Handlers will be permitted to throw an object of their choice (tennis ball, bumper, Dokken Dead Fowl Trainer, etc.) off the "dock" and into the water to help encourage their dog to build speed as he/she runs down the 45' dock and leaps into the pool below. The dog that jumps the farthest wins. Although it will be presented to the audience as a "trial" in fact it will be more of an entertaining, family orientated show. We expect the media to take an interest in the Big Air show and some of the dogs might make it into the papers or be seen on TV.

### **Who Can Participate**

Seven dog / handler teams will be competing two or three times daily for the public. These same seven dog / handler teams will compete each of the five days of the Toronto Sportsmen's Show. An audition to help determine which seven dogs will compete will be held on Tuesday afternoon March 13th. All interested dog / handler teams should pre-register for the auditions. Only seven of the dogs at the try outs will be selected to compete. Dogs will be selected based on a number of criteria including; how far they jump, how high they jump, uniqueness of breed, entertainment value and temperament. **Each handler selected will be paid a daily fee of \$125.00 plus parking and a meal voucher.** Handlers and their dogs will be required to be at the Sportsmen's Show for the duration of each of the five days. All dogs must have their vaccinations up to date and be human and dog friendly.
